Communication On Progress (COP) - 2010 - Principle 8 (Environment)

Conscious of its responsibility for the environment, the directors of the Cella Group have implemented a simple and efficient system for collecting used paper, in collaboration with a recycling business. Each office in our Paris head office is equipped with a 20 litres bin made of recycled carton destined for paper documents and cardboard. To date, 20 bins are in service.

The recycling company replaces the bins when at least 10 of them are full.
This system was preceded by a survey and explanations of the challenge given to the staff.

After 5 months' use, we note the replacement of 10 bins every 2 months, which means for the Paris head office, a theoretical annual amount of 1 200 litres of paper to be recycled.

We consider this is a very positive result, which shows the interest of the head office staff for actions concerning environmental respect.

This is just the first step among many: other actions will follow (collection of used computer components, replacement of all electrical light bulbs in the head office,...) led by the directors and colleagues of the Cella Group.
